

Improved Roads

Taking advantage of the recent rain, the road grader and roller were this week sent over Winterwood boulevard and over six miles of road leading south from Vegas toward Paradise Valley.

Although the rain was not sufficient to give a thorough wetting to the soil, the work resulted in putting the grade on the Winterwood boulevard in fair shape for automobiles, so that the foundation is furnished for building a splendid drive.

The road south of town was also put in much better condition than ever before. Street Commissioner E. W. Griffith went over the road in the big Thomas car belonging to Walter Rogers Thanksgiving day with a party of guests. The machine, carrying eight people, came in from the Clark-Ronnow ranch in 27 minutes without the least trouble, illustrating to a certain extent, the advantages which would result from systematic road improvement.
