

# WINTERWOOD RANCH SOLD

## Princely Domain Passes Into Possession of Japanese Syndicate

Through the agency of R. S. McBride of Los Angeles, who has had the deal under way for several months, the princely domain of the Winterwood Land Co., comprising 5,000 acres of the choicest land in the Vegas Valley, only four miles from this city, has been sold to a syndicate of Japanese capitalists.

The property was purchased in June 1911, by the Winterwood Land Company. After clearing and leveling 600 acres of land and sinking several wells the enterprise has lain dormant for the past two years.

John C. Winter and John M. Prophet of Mt Morris, N. Y., and Chas. H. Palmer of Ely, Nev., are said to be the principal owners of the selling company. The price obtained is not known but it is said to show a fair profit on the investment. The important feature of the deal so far as Vegas is concerned is that this land will be immediately brought under cultivation.
